The design of the Sumitomo Pavilion is inspired by the "peaks of the Besshi Mountains" in Shikoku, Japan where the foundation of Sumitomo's growth was established; and features a silhouette of its mountain ranges. The Pavilion is built with the trees of the "Sumitomo Forest", which has lived through more than 400 years of Sumitomo history. The lumber is processed into "plywood" based on the concept of "valuing each life, one tree at a time" and ensuring that the tree is used in its entirety. Furthermore, the leftover "peeling core" from peeling the logs will be turned into benches to be set up throughout the space.

The pavilion will make effective use of wood resources while also recycling to balance both ecology and economy and ultimately creating a building that offers the warmth and healing powers of wood. We will proceed with preparations in our aim to build a pavilion that will portray our hopes for the future and captivate the hearts of many.

There are less than 500 days to the opening of Expo 2025 Osaka, Kansai. The Sumitomo Group will gather the wisdom, technology, and talent garnered to present and address social issues through the collective powers of the group. We will showcase exhibitions that move people's hearts, promote change, and create hope for the future; along with aspirational entertainment to create a place where people can gather and start conversations.
